We offer educational programming to the parents, care givers, and siblings and people with developmental disabilities. We offer support groups for families with someone with a developmental disability. We offer enrichment for individuals with disabilities. But we are not limited to that, we tailor our services around what the family needs.

# WHAT IS THE BUDDY WALK?

The Buddy Walk is a celebration of individuals with Down syndrome. It is our largest fundraiser of the year, as well as the biggest community engagement opportunity. There are many ways to help. Individuals can volunteer, register to walk, create a team and encourage others to join in the fun, create a fundraiser at their school, workplace or organization, spread the word via social media or by asking businesses to sponsor or create a team, or help send out materials to organizations & businesses. Businesses are encouraged to create a Buddy Walk team, donate to or sponsor the event. We are expecting around 600 people to participate at this year's event.

We are looking for sponsors of this event that align with the mission of our organization, and believe that community inclusion is important because all people, regardless of their abilities, should be able to participate and engage in a full range of community activities. At DSNNN, the principles of community inclusion inform and fuel all of our programs.

Community inclusion is the opportunity to live and exist as a contributing member of the community while being valued for one's abilities and uniqueness — regardless of disability. The ultimate goal of community inclusion is the participation of people with IDDs across a range of areas, including employment, housing, education, recreation and leisure, civic engagement, peer support and more.
